

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR MANUSCRIPTS

The manuscripts submitted for consideration by the Scientific Journal "Acta Academiae Beregsasiensis. Economics":

 \succ Should be contemporary, original and independent research that have never been published before and have not been submitted for consideration in other publications;

 \succ should not contain:

- materials prohibited for printing,

- materials whose authenticity is in doubt,

- inappropriate textual borrowings without valid references (plagiarism), self-plagiarism (large-scale borrowing from one's own works without providing proper references).

The structure of the article should include the following necessary elements (based on the requirements of the Resolution of the Presidium of the HAC of Ukraine of $15.01.2003 \text{ N}_{2}7-05.1$):

8. **Problem description.** Statement of the problem in general and its connection with important scientific or practical tasks.

9. Literature review. Analysis of recent research and publications, which initiated the solution of this problem and on which the author relies, highlighting previously unresolved parts of the general problem, which is the subject of this article.

10. Formulation of the **goals of the article** (task setting).

11. **Results and discussions.** Presentation of the main material of the study with a full justification of the obtained scientific results.

12. Conclusions and prospects for further research in this area.

13. **References**. List of sources used are numbered according to the order of reference in the text. The reference to the source is given in square brackets; bibliographic description of the literature is made in accordance with the National Standard of Ukraine "Bibliographic reference" (DSTU 8302: 2015). The number of self-citations should not exceed 20%.

According to the rules that take into account the requirements of international citation systems, authors of articles must provide a list of references in two versions: one in the original language and in a separate block the same list of References in the Roman alphabet (Harvard reference system, or APA-style), repeating it in the same order all sources of literature, regardless of whether they are foreign

Manuscript parameters:

• languages of writing the manuscript - Ukrainian, Hungarian, English;

• number of co-authors - **not more than 3**;

 \bullet volume of the manuscript – 4-20 pages, including figures and tables; page format - A4,

- page orientation "book"; margins: top, bottom, left 2.5 cm, right 2.5 cm;
- font Times New Roman, 13; line spacing 1.0;



• the manuscript must be prepared using the Word for Windows® editor as a single file in DOC or DOCX format without macros;

• the abstract to the article should be expanded (1800 characters with spaces).
